Academic Opportunities

The Maple Lake School Board is dedicated to employing highly qualified faculty members who are appropriately licensed in each academic area. Our students have a history of scoring well on state assessments geared to measure the academic progress of students and schools.

Academic offerings are enhanced through partnerships with Southwest Minnesota State University and Lake Superior College, which allow our students to earn up to 37 college credits by successfully completing college level courses at Maple Lake High School. Our membership in the Wright Technical Center provides students with access to 12 job-related courses including auto

mechanics, medical careers, cosmetology, law enforcement and firefighting. Licensed teachers and paraprofessionals work in Maple Lake Public Schools to offer a comprehensive special education program in conjunction with the Meeker and Wright Special Education Cooperative.



Community Education

Our community education program features an assortment of opportunities for learners of all ages. Arts and crafts, athletics, group trips, theater and a variety of classes are offered to students and community members. Preschool programs include on-site classes, Early Childhood Family Education opportunities for families with young children and Kidville, our on-site daycare that is staffed from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on weekdays.

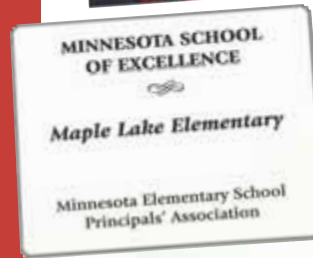


Geographic Area Served

Maple Lake Public Schools serves about 875 preschool through 12th grade students in a beautiful rural setting. Maple Lake is located 40 miles west of the Twin Cities and 30 miles southeast of St. Cloud. Neighboring communities include Monticello to the northeast, Buffalo to the east, Howard Lake to the south and Annandale to the west. State Highway 55 runs through the City of Maple Lake and Interstate 94 lies eight miles to our north via County Road 8.



The mission of Maple Lake Public Schools is to create an exceptional place to learn and work, emphasizing educational opportunities that promote academic achievement, life-long learning, and productive citizenship in our society.

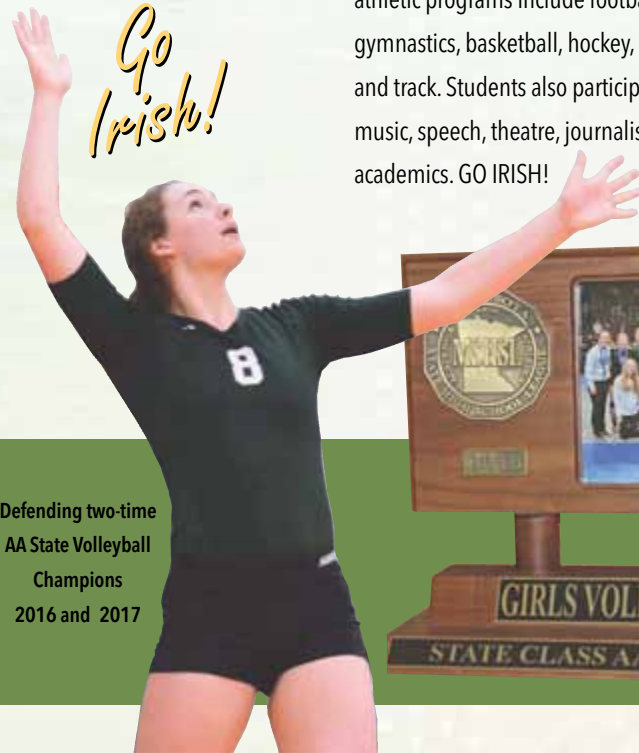


Life in Maple Lake

Caed Mile Failte (Kayd Meelah Fallchaa) is an Irish saying that means "A Hundred Thousand Welcomes to you." This welcome has been adopted by the Maple Lake community, which celebrates its Irish roots during our community's annual St. Patrick's Day Celebration. The festivities include the Irish 5k Scamper, an annual craft sale, a 100+ unit parade and the coronation of the Maple Lake Ambassadors.

Families move here to enjoy small town life, affordable housing, and the tranquil countryside. While Maple Lake residents access major transportation routes to commute to their jobs, many employment opportunities also exist in town. The school district employs about 130 employees and is one of our community's larger employers. Community members find Maple Lake a happy balance of small town values with access to larger communities.

Facilities

Maple Lake Elementary School and Maple Lake High School are located on a single campus that provides our students, staff and community with modern, well-maintained facilities. Up-to-date technology includes five computer labs, several servers, wireless internet, iPads, laptop computers, Smart Boards and workstations in each elementary and high school classroom. Trained personnel maintain our technology and work with community members and staff to plan for the future of technology in our schools. Our media centers provide students and staff with a wide variety of printed and electronic resources, and Maple Lake has some of the finest indoor and outdoor athletic facilities in the area.

Community Support. Maple Lake Schools receive strong support from our community. Voters approved a new operating levy and a new technology bond in 2017. School events are well attended and 500 people of all ages volunteer in a variety of capacities throughout the school year.
